Baptism illustrates Christ's death, burial, and resurrection.

"Christ died for our sins...He was buried...and He was raised up on the third day." I Cor. 15:3-4

"Having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead." Col. 2:12

Baptism illustrates my new life as a Christian.

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!!" 2 Cor. 5:17

"We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life." Rom. 6:4

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8, 9

Baptism doesn't make you a believer-it shows that you already believe. Baptism does not "save" you, only Christ's work on the cross can provide us salvation through faith in Him. Baptism is like a wedding ring-it's the outward symbol of the commitment you made in your heart.
