- 1 My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart.
- 2 For they will prolong your life many years and bring you prosperity.
- 3 Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart.
- 4 Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man.
- 5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
- 6 in all your ways acknowledge to him, and he will make your paths straight.
- 7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil.
- 8 This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.
- 9 Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops;
- 10 then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.
- 11 My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline, and do not resent his rebuke,
- 12 because the Lord disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in.
- 13 Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding,
- 14 for she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold.
- 15 She is more precious than rubies; nothing you desire can compare with her.
- 16 Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor.
- 17 Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace.
- 18 She is a tree of life to those who embrace her; those who lay hold her fast will be blessed.
- 19 By wisdom the Lord laid the earth's foundations, by understanding he set the heavens in place.
- 20 By his knowledge the deeps were divided, and the clouds let drop the dew.
- 21 My son, preserve sound judgement and discernment; do not let them out of your sight;
- 22 they will be life for you, an ornament to grace your neck.
- 23 Then you will go on your way in safety, and your foot will not stumble.
- 24 When you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet.

Scholarship & Awards

This is why we have Journey Through the Bible! Each week at Journey, we will be assigning, tracking and encouraging students to strive for the goals listed below. On Awards Night, Wednesday, **May 14, 2025**, we will acknowledge and award any/all students achieving the following:

Perfect Attendance Award

This award goes to any student with **PERFECT ATTENDANCE** from September thru May. This student will receive a **FREE** movie night out on us for their consistent commitment to Journey throughout the year!

Outreach Award

This award goes to the student that **INVITES** the most **NEW** friends to Journey this year. This student will receive a Gift Card to ChristianBookDistributors.com. (Each new friend counts only once.)

Journey Gospellica Award

This award goes to any student that **COMPLETES** their Journey program. (This means 75% attendance, wearing their class color, bringing their Bible, reciting their assigned verses, and participating in Service opportunities/Challenges.) These students will receive \$10 in **JOURNEY** bucks and will be the 2nd group to shop at the Awards Night **JOURNEY STORE**.

Scripture Memory Award

This award goes to any student who **RECITES** ALL their memory passage at one time on **April 16th or 23rd**. These students will receive a trophy on Awards Night and will be the 1st group to shop at the Awards Night **JOURNEY STORE**!

Track Award

This award goes to any student who has at least 75% attendance, wearing their class color, bringing their Bible, completing **TWO** Service requirements, **AND** finally stays ON **TRACK** with their scripture memory (does not go ahead or fall behind more than two weeks). These students will be eligible for **FREE** admission to the **STRAND ADVENTURES Party on Friday, May 16th**. **NOTE:** There is a reason this incentive is bigger than the others. It is because we want our children at young ages to get into healthy spiritual habits of serving and daily being in God's Word!
