

2 Timothy 2:1-26

The Appeal Renewed

1 You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. [Due September 21]

2 And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others. [Due September 28]

3 Endure hardship with us like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. [Due October 5]

4 No one serving as a soldier gets involved in civilian affairs--he wants to please his commanding officer. [Due October 12]

5 Similarly, if anyone competes as an athlete, he does not receive the victor's crown unless he competes according to the rules. [Due October 19]

6 The hardworking farmer should be the first to receive a share of the crops. [Due October 26]

7 Reflect on what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all this. [Due November 2]

8 Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel, [Due November 9]

9 for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained. [Due November 16]

10 Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. [Due November 30]

11 Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with Him, we will also live with Him; [Due December 7]

12 if we endure, we will also reign with Him. If we disown Him, He will also disown us; [Due December 14]

13 if we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot disown Himself. [Due December 21]

14 Keep reminding them of these things. Warn them before God against quarreling about words; it is of no value, and only ruins those who listen. [Due January 18, 2023]

2 Timothy 2:1-26

15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth. [Due January 25, 2023]

16 Avoid godless chatter, because those who indulge in it will become more and more ungodly. [Due February 1, 2023]

17 Their teaching will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, [Due February 8, 2023]

18 who have wandered away from the truth. They say that the resurrection has already taken place, and they destroy the faith of some. [Due February 15, 2023]

19 Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness." [Due February 22, 2023]

20 In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. [Due March 1, 2023]

21 If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work. [Due March 8, 2023]

22 Flee the evil desires of youth and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart. [Due March 15, 2023]

23 Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. [Due March 29, 2023]

24 And the Lord's servant must not quarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. [Due April 5, 2023]

25 Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, [Due April 12, 2023]

26 and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will. [Due April 19, 2023]
